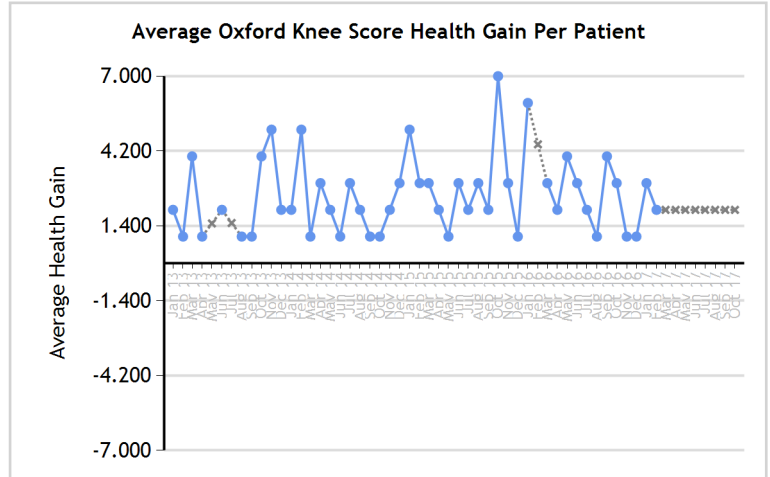
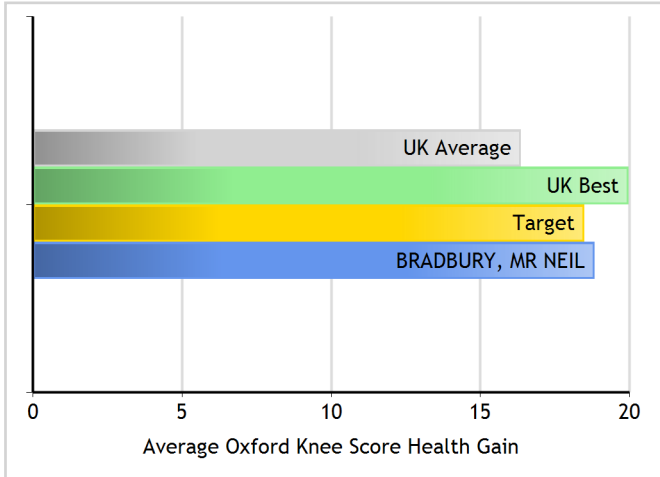

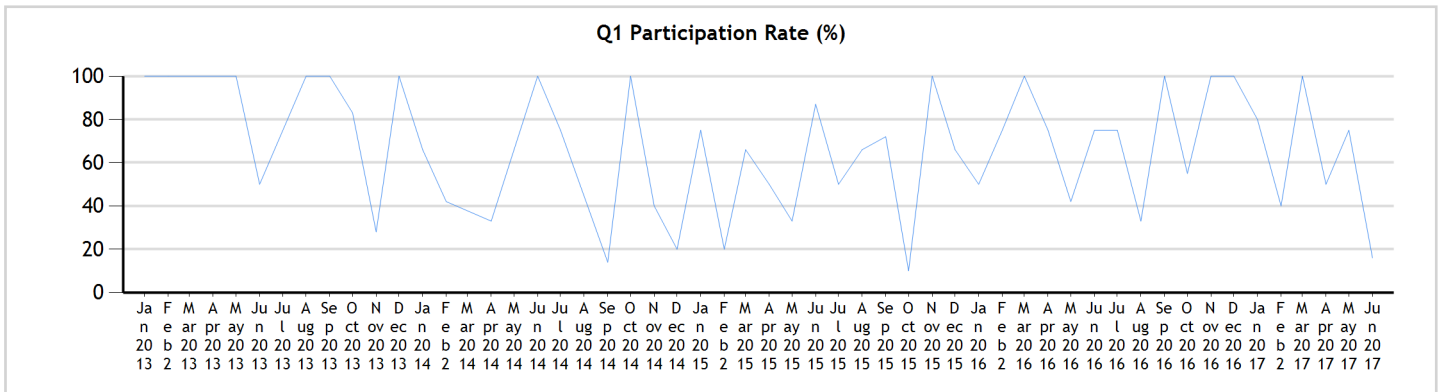

### Notes

1. Target: to be among the top 10 providers in the UK. In order to reach 10th place a minimum score of 18.495 is currently required.
2. Oxford Knee Score: UK validated questionnaire, 12 questions, minimum score is 0, maximum score is 48.
3. Average health gain: post-op score minus pre-op score.
4. Comparisons based on HSCIC unadjusted scores for a minimum amount of 30 patients.
5. Gaps (where no patients were surveyed) in charts are represented in grey.
6. Current ranking: based on our current score and compared with unadjusted scores for other hospitals in the UK.
7. Data for comparison sourced from Health and Social Care Information Centre website <http://www.hscic.gov.uk/PROMs>
8. Reporting period: based on surgery dates (see exception below). More patients' scores will be available each month, and as a result the average health gain for previous months could change over time.
9. When calculating Q1 received for Participation rate the reporting period is based on Q1 received date rather than surgery date.
